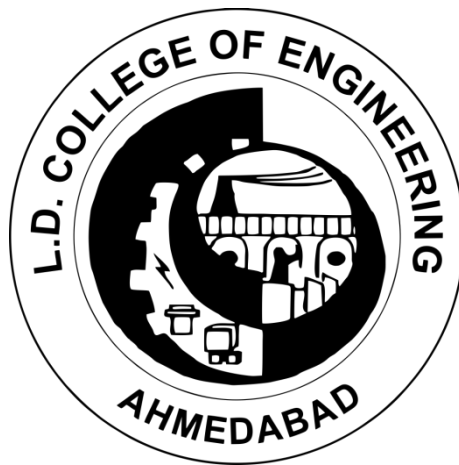

Introduction

The Mid semester examination was arranged every semester of all subjects and all classes together in a week. It seems that due to pressure of study of all subjects students inspired to stop attending the classes. In HOD meeting it is decided to stop this phenomena through Academic Calender of Institute. It is decided to arrange the mid semester examination on all working Saturday, will be declared before semester. This new system will broaden the teaching learning process. Since all exams are arranged at gap of 15 days, students will never feel the stress and he/she can concentrate on their learning process, can attend the classes/tutorial/practical up to last session. This broadening will definitely encourage the students for continuous learning.

Notice to Students

- (1) It has been decided to use Google classroom from sem 1 and sem 3 for this academic semester for the purpose of tutorial and practical work.
- (2) Grading system for every subject as per GTU norms is as mentioned below:

$$70 \text{ ESE(E)} + 30 \text{ PA(M)} + 30 \text{ ESE/Viva (V)} + 20 \text{ PA(I)} = 150 \text{ Total}$$

Marks

- (3) It is to be noted that 30 PA(M) would be derived from the exams conducted according to the academic calendar. In case of remedial exam, here teacher is empowered to arrange assignments through Google classrooms instead of remedial exam. Students will be allowed to sit in any exam provided the students have at least 75% attendance in the particular subject class.
- (4) As every tutorial and practical is to be submitted via Google classroom, student will be asked oral questions at the time of each and every submission to assess knowledge of work done, marks of which would serve as marks of PA(I) (out of 20) i.e. Google classroom activity marks would be the marks of PA(I) (out of 20). **Hence there is no requirement to arrange submission schedule.**
- (5) The marks for ESE/Viva (out of 30) would be given as per the attendance of the students in classroom (out of 20) and his/her performance in viva (out of 10) at the end of semester. Attendance will be calculated by below mentioned formula.
