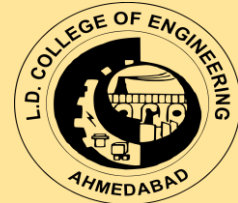


## INTRODUCTORY COMMENTS AND MESSAGE

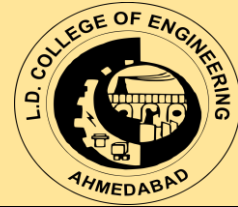
**Figure 1: Participants at Registration Desk**

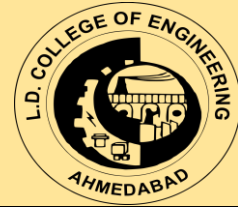

**Figure 4: Honorable Dignitaries on the Dias**

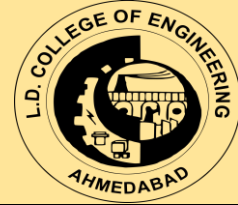


### **B. Welcome Address by Principal**

**Figure 5: Welcome Address by Dr. R.K.Gajjar, Principal, LDCE Ahmedabad**



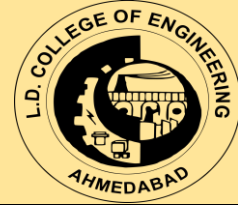
### C. Address By The GTU-VC

**Figure 6: Address by Dr. Navin Sheth, Honourable GTU-VC**



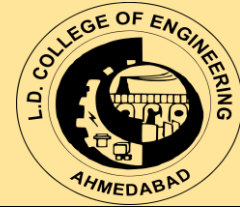


#### **D. Vote of Thanks**

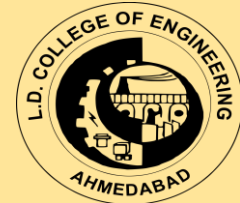
### **Quality Initiatives awareness by Col. B. Venkat, Director, RIFD, AICTE, H.Q.**

**Figure 8: Expert Lecture 1: Col. B. Venkat, Director, RIFD, AICTE, New Delhi**



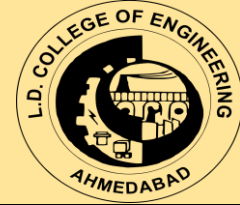
## **EXPERT LECTURE: 2**
