He joined the Space Applications Centre in 1987. He is a communication payload specialist and has been responsible for the development of many

payload subsystems and implementation of many new technologies/hardware in the GEOSAT/IRNSS Satellites & Ground systems and is the Deputy Project Director in the Indian Mars Mission. Under the Disaster Management Support Program of ISRO, he has personally led the teams from the Space Applications Centre, Ahmedabad to the Disaster Zones for providing Satellite Communication support during Uttarakhand and J&K disasters. He has also served as a Senior Diplomat (Counselor), representing ISRO in the USA, at the Embassy of India, Washington DC (2005-2008).
