Bosch Artisan Training Center at Electrical Dept., LDCE



The ATC has been set up with necessary hardware and training material/equipment that includes workbenches, hand tools, power tools, activity tables, classroom furniture, safety equipment, course contents with course modules, training manuals with pedagogy, and display material.



The ATC will offer long term course, workshops, and training sessions in Electrical Electronics trade that equip youths with essential life skills, vocational skills, technical skills, and soft skills required to succeed in today's competitive world

LDCE has more than 1200 students in first year. It shall train these students as a part of curriculum in laboratory hours in the subjects such as basics of Electrical engineering, Electrical Workshop etc. After implementing training to their own students, if the time slot permits, it shall cater the training to nearby degree, diploma institutes. The training shall be imparted for a gainful employment or becoming an entrepreneur for a sustained livelihood.
