

INDUSTRY INTERACTION

The visit included sites of various tall buildings such as Trogon Twin Towers, Harmony Harikesh, and Times 104. Accompanied by professors, a total of 40 students explored these sites, gaining practical insights into structural engineering and geotechnical aspects.

Vibrant Gujarat Global Summit


